
Dr. Hugo Heyrman The Double Life of Images

The extensive exhibition **Dr. Hugo Heyrman The Double Life of Images** (2019) includes more than 50 works. Since the 1960s, he has developed as one of the most important painters of his generation. In essence, his work is about the mysterious double life of images — it opens up a transitional space between reality, memory and imagination.

Painter of postmodern life: The enigmatic paintings of Dr. Hugo Heyrman are characterized by a pictural intensity and a resonance of the images. Through the mysterious double life of images we enter the dimension of an inner sense of time — where a glance becomes a private dream. As a painter of 'atmospheres of change', he creates a pictorial space that opens up in a plural of significance. His commitment to the world, as a pictorial reality, touches us a place outside space and time — in the eye of the 'maelstrom', surrounded by a changing 'zeitgeist'.
